1. Who We Are

QuickWins Consulting is an executive coaching practice specialising in support for neurodivergent professionals and leaders. References to 'we', 'us', or 'our' in this policy refer to QuickWins Consulting.

2. What Information We Collect

We collect information you provide directly to us when you submit an enquiry through our contact form. This includes your first and last name, email address, job title, current professional situation, coaching goals, time zone, and how you heard about us.

We do not collect any sensitive personal data, financial information, or automatically track your behaviour on our website beyond standard server logs maintained by our hosting provider (Netlify).

3. How We Use Your Information

We use the information you provide solely to respond to your enquiry, assess whether our coaching services are a good fit for your needs, and follow up on your request for a discovery call.

If you give explicit consent, we may send you relevant coaching resources and updates. You can withdraw this consent at any time by emailing us or clicking unsubscribe in any communication.

4. How We Store Your Information

Your enquiry data is stored securely in Airtable, a cloud-based data platform. Airtable is GDPR-compliant and stores data on servers within the United States under Standard Contractual Clauses.

We retain your data for as long as necessary to manage our coaching relationship with you, or for up to 2 years following your last contact with us if no coaching engagement begins.

5. Sharing Your Information

We do not sell, rent, or share your personal information with third parties for marketing purposes. We may share your data with service providers who help us operate our business (such as Airtable for data storage and Netlify for website hosting), solely for the purpose of delivering our services to you.

6. Your Rights

Under applicable data protection law, you have the right to access the personal data we hold about you, request correction of inaccurate data, request deletion of your data, withdraw consent at any time, and lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.
